

WARREN RANCH RULES

- All persons entering upon any portion of Warren Ranch L.P. property must sign a GENERAL RELEASE, INDEMNITY, AND AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT immediately upon arrival at the property or in any event prior to participating in any activities on the property.
- All persons participating in hunting activities must have a valid Texas hunting license on his or her person at all times, and must obey all state and federal game laws, rules or regulations.
- Consumption of alcohol or any controlled substance or drug during the period beginning 6 hours prior to any hunting activities (or firearm use) through the conclusion of such hunting activity (or firearm use) is prohibited.
- A Warren Ranch representative must be present for all shooting related activities.
- No firearms of any kind are permitted in any of the ranch facilities, except the lodge gunroom. All firearms must be unloaded and remain unloaded at all times except during hunting or shooting activities.
- Check-in time is no earlier than 4:00 p.m. on the day of arrival. Check-out time is no later than 11:00 a.m. on the day of departure. Any alternative arrangements must be expressly approved by Warren Ranch prior to arrival.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the ranch facilities. High caution should be taken when smoking outdoors to ensure your cigarette or cigar is completely extinguished.
- Pets or other animals are not permitted inside any of the ranch facilities.
- Safety is the top priority during any shooting activity. Any ranch representative may require a participant to stop a shooting activity should they deem, at their sole discretion, that the participant is being unsafe and is a danger to others.
- Unescorted travel through the ranch is not permitted at any time without the permission of an authorized ranch representative.
- Shooting of an unauthorized animal or destruction of Warren Ranch L.P. property will be added to the total amount due from customer at those rates currently in place at the time of the occurrence.
- All hunting and shooting activities must be conducted at locations designated by an authorized ranch representative. Hunting or shooting at any other locations is prohibited.
- If you shoot at a deer or turkey, that animal counts against your hunt package. Every reasonable effort will be made to track and secure wounded game.
- All persons should leave the Warren Ranch L.P. property as it was found and must, among other things, pick up all spent shells/casings and litter.
- All children 13 years of age and under must wear a life vest while swimming.
- No outside fires during burn ban.
